December 9 Quiz Reminders. The venue is St Paul Lutheran Church and School Northville, 201 Elm St, Northville, MI 48167. To get there from I-275, exit at Eight Mile Road and head west for 2.5 miles, turn left (south) on N Center St, turn right (west) on Walnut St, turn left (south) on East St, and at Elm pull in to the church and school parking lot.

The opening meeting will start at noon in the church.
In the Little League rooms, there will be some smaller chairs available for smaller quizzers.
Following the quizzing competition, there will be some Christmas-themed activities in the school gym, i.e., a party.

Chicago 2024. Since this season the Chicago Tournament is coming just one week after the March Day of Champions Tournament, an open invitation is extended to all quizzers to go to the Tournament on DBQ teams.


Qualifying under DBQ Rule 6.5 .2 is still relevant as (1) quali-
fied quizzers will be put on teams together, (2) any empty spots will be filled with non-qualified quizzers, and (3) remaining non-qualified quizzers will then be put on teams together. Remember, qualifying has two parts: (1) production-a 20-point season average for veterans or a 10 -point season average for rookies, and (2) participation-don't miss more than one day of quizzing from October to February (and you need to be present for March).

The preparatory timeline will be (1) online preregistration in January, (2) commitment to making the trip by paying the Tournament fees and costs in February, (3) make a hotel registration, and (4) attend the All Teams Practice on Sunday, March 10. Additional information will be provided at the December 9 quiz.
Promotion. Detroit Bible Quizzing has again grown this season (for the fourth year in a row). Let's not stop. Promote quizzing throughout this season. Recruit family, friends, acquaintances. Get them to a practice or monthly quiz. Encourage, persuade or drag them (be nice) into quizzing.


## Tidbits

Honorable Mention. Once frozen, there is no guarantee that a quizzer will have an opportunity to jump and score again. Three frozen chairs without error in a day of quizzing equals 210 points. When quizzers get that many points or more and yet don't make Quizzer of the Month, they deserve some recognition. In November, three Little League and four Varsity quizzers attained this distinction:

Rookie Watch. A great part of quizzing is to see which rookies start off strong and which are able to catch on later and make a run for the top spot. This season there are lots of rookies to watch.
In Varsity, Sam Zurek's 170 points vaulted him into the top rookie spot. Jacob Zurek both got multiple scores. Elliot Mayer had 120, Gabe Ruth 30 and Jacob Zurek 20.

In Little League, Everett Smith (210) remains at the top of the rookie list, now followed by Cady Phou (230—good for Quizzer of the Month and a jump from 14th to 7th overall), Veda Smith (140) and Kaleb Nunez (110), all quizzing at an All Star level. Also scoring in triple digits were Clara Nelson, Jonah Kittleman and Lachlan D'Annunzio (his first 130). Three more also got their first score: Asher Friesen, Levi Devereaux and Nolan Dawe.
Make a point to encourage the rookies.

MCC Unto Death-100, MCC Sword of the Spirit-90, SCC Better Than a Slave-80 Marimont Sword of the Spirit scored all its points by question 8 as Samuel Kochenspar-


MCC Unto Death ger froze his chair without error and added a toss-up. Marimont Unto Death was right behind as Katie Baugh froze without error on 9 and added a freebie on 13b. Stony Creek made the score 80-90-80 as Xander Bourdeau scored and Micah Drada froze his chair on 14. Each team had their number 2 quizzer eligible to jump, and they let 15 and 16 go by. On 17, Madalyn Lutz got the jump, the score and the nail-biter win for Unto Death.
CP Tear Out Your Eyes-70, SCC Better Than A Slave-80, SCC Called To Freedom-20 Xander Bourdeau of Better Than A Slave, Kara Russell of Called To Freedom and CrossPoint's Kylie Phillips answered the first three questions in that order. Kylie took two more to freeze without error; Better Than A Slave's Micah Drada scored thrice to freeze, and Kara added a score. Question 15 started with the score 70-80-40. The SCC teams erred for -10 each but CP couldn't capitalize. Question 16 went into the books as (1) a CP foul for an ineligible quizzer getting the jump, (2) a Better Than A Slave foul for an uncontrolled reaction to CP's foul and -10 as it was the team's second foul, and (3) a Called To Freedom error for -10 . On 17, Better Xander got his second jump to win it.

Each team started with a frozen chair without error: Swordsman Sam Kochensparger on 6, Lake Pointe's Megan Yonker on 8 and Living Aiden Baugh on 10. Swordsman Ryder Perry scored twice for a 40-point lead. LP Rookie Elliot Mayer cut that lead in half. Living Rebekah Catanzaro closed out regulation with two scores and the need for a Marimont tiebreaker. Aiden followed up a Sword error with a freebie for the win.

Starting question 15 , the score was 80-60-70-anyone's quiz. Each team had two quizzers eligible on 15 to jump for the win, but only one could get it and that was the Shark's Ellie Norton.

Starting question 15 , the score was $60-40-$ 70 -anyone's quiz. The all-rookie Faith EPC Padawans had two scores by Kaleb Nunez and one by Asher Friesen; the all-rookie Faith EPC Kids had two scores by Lachlan D'Annunzio; St. Paul Northville had a score by Caleb Norton and a frozen chair without error by Silas Pennington but -20 for five team errors.
