#### Plan now for Chicago.

Detroit Bible Quizzing will be putting together teams of qualified quizzers to compete at the WBQA Chicago Tournament, now recognized as the World Championship. To qualify, a quizzer must meet two requirements. First: have a 20-point average as a veteran or a 10-point average as a rookie. This season, five veterans have already scored

enough points (420+) to guarantee themselves the required average. Second: have a strong attendance record, meaning that you miss no more than one day of quizzing between October and February. You need to be at the March competition, since that has an extended format of six quizzes rather than the usual three. Plan now, and we'll see you in Chicago.




Marimont RefreshUrMemory

Heart scored first with **Owen Parker** grabbing question 1. Marimont's Katie Baugh immediately scored three in a row to freeze without error. Heart got the next two scores as Owen froze without error to tie at 70. Rookie Rebekah Catanzaro scored to retake the lead for Marimont. Toss-ups taken by Katie and Owen preserved the status quo over the next four questions. With three questions left, determined CrossPoint rookie Anna Grinnell let out all the stops to try and score. An error on 13 ended in a freebie to Katie for a 30-point lead. An error on 14 led to Owen getting the toss-up to cut the lead to 10. An error on 15 led to Katie getting the toss-up to claim the win for Marimont.

SPN You Need Milk–40 ♥ Double-Edged Sword–110 LP Preprd 2 Give a Defense–90 The top of the standings changed again in December as Heart became the third team in as many months with the number one ranking. It started with this narrow win over the first-place team

from November. Heart's Kaleb Caron-Martin scored on questions 1, 2 and 4 to freeze without error. Lake Pointe's Sophia Fike matched that on questions 3, 6 and 9. Surrounding her last score, Kaleb got both toss-ups in the quiz for a 40-point lead. Erin Yonker scored to pull Lake Pointe within 20, but down the stretch St. Paul's Jack Smith picked up two scores and Heart's lead held up for the win. Heart was the only team to win all three of its December quizzes and that was enough to move it up from third place into first place by just a single Olympic point.

the Defenders. Cordelia then scored two in a row to freeze without error, immediately followed by Sophia doing the same. Two Heart errors ended in freebies to Cordelia and Sophia, so going into question 13 the score was 20-80-80. Was Heart out of it? Not a chance. Owen Parker scored two

Following a Tribe error, Owen got the toss-up to end regulation, putting Heart into a tie-breaker with the Defensive ones and relegating the Tribe to third place. On the first tie-breaker, a Lake Pointe error gave Heart the chance to win on a freebie, but Heart had to settle for an attempt. On the second tie-breaker, a Heart error gave Lake Pointe the freebie, and Megan Yonker made no mistake for the win. The win meant that Lake Pointe ended the day in second rather than dropping to third.

Marimont is on the north side of Walton Boulevard in Pontiac just west of Telegraph Road. The driveway into the parking lot is on the west side of the church.

#### via M-59 from the east:

Come west to Woodward, turn right and half-way around the loop turn right on Cesar E Chavez Avenue. At Telegraph, turn right. At Walton, turn left and the church will be on your right.

#### from the I-696 corridor:

From the east, take I-75 north to M-59 and follow the directions above. From the west, take Telegraph north all the way to Walton, turn left and the church will be on your right.
