## Varsity Quiz Highlights

LP This is Impossible-90, SCC The Wise Ones-0, Marimont Myrrh-120
Marimont's Katie Baugh and Lake Pointe's Sophia Fike went toe to toe until they both
 froze, Sophia without error for a 10 -point lead. That left only three quizzers eligible to jump as LP and Marimont were two-person teams and Stony Creek Church was down two of its quizzers on this day. LP's Megan Yonker and Marimont's Rebekah Catanzaro each scored. On a toss-up, Katie regained the lead: $90-0-100$. On question 15. Rebekah sealed the Marimont win.

SCC Built on the Rock-10, Marimont Gold-190, CP Take the Children's Bread-20 Marimont had 110 points by question 6 as Owen Parker froze without error and Anna Sanchez added 40. Sam Hatfield, one of two veterans in the SCC rookie quiz program, got SCC its first points ever. The next three scores were all Marimont as Owen got a toss-up, Anna froze without error and picked up a freebie. Vicky Edwards scored to pull CrossPoint even with SCC. With second place on the line, SCC rookie Caleb Loyd got his first jump ever but came up short on the answer. On the toss-up, Owen got his fifth score of the quiz; Marimont's 190 was the high score on the day.
Marimont Gold-50, LP This is Impossible-90, LP What do you want with us?-80 What do you want with us?' Cordelia Fike scored the first 80 points. The next 80 were split evenly between Owen Parker and Sophia Fike, but then Sophia got another 40 to tie for the lead.
