Varsity Quiz Highlights

SCC Fishers of Men-80, Marimont Gold-180, Marimont Frankincense-60 Gold's **Owen Parker** and **Anna Sanchez** both froze without error by question 6. Stony

Creek rookie Lauren Franz scored twice, quickly matched by Frankincense's Kaleb Caron-Martin. SCC rookie Kara Russell promptly broke the tie for second. The battle for second led to two errors in the quiz and Owen took advantage for 40 more points to help his run to Quizzer of the Month. On the next-to-last question, Kaleb froze to tie for second. On the first tie-breaker, Lauren froze to claim second place.

Marimont Myrrh-60, LP What do you want with us?-170, CP Take the Children's Bread-70 Here's another quiz with four frozen chairs and just two errors (but the toss-ups were taken by people not yet frozen). Lake Pointe's Cordelia Fike was first to score and first to freeze without error. Marimont's Katie Baugh kept it close, freezing on the next question. LP took a big lead as Carmen Yonker froze without error. Victoria Edwards froze without error to move CrossPoint into second place. Annabelle Fales scored on question 15 to put on exclamation point on Lake Pointe's win, adding a third-person bonus.

Marimont Frankincense-70, SCC Built on the Rock-50, Marimont Myrrhs-90 Myrrh's Katie Baugh took the first three for a 70-point lead. After that she got back in on a toss-up only one time while five questions were passed. Frankincense spread out 60 points between a score by Adeline Sanchez and two by Kaleb-Caron-Martin by question 14. Stony Creek spread out 60 point between a score by rookie Caleb Loyd and two by Sam Hatfield by question 15. For the tie-breaker, after three passed questions, SCC tried but came up short and Kaleb got the freebie to claim second.

What a turn-around in this quiz! CrossPoint had three errors, an attempt and no points through question 8. By that tme, Tiny Tots rookie Eli Blum had scored 40 points, and

right after it Fishers rookies Kara Russell and Lauren Franz combined for 40. Tiny Tots rookie Micah Drada retook the lead with 20. But then CP's Victoria Edwards scored three in a row to tie for the lead. Going into question 15, the score was 60–40–60, so it was anyone's quiz to win. A Tiny Tots error opened the door for Victoria to get her fourth score and the come-from-behind win.

Little League Quiz Highlights

SCC Vipers-120, LP Little League-0, SCC Alabaster Jars-70

This quiz was much closer than it looks by the final score. By question 8, the Viper's **Clifton Leslie** had 80 points on his way to a stellar repeat as Quizzer of the Month. By question 13, Alabaster Jars pulled into a tie as **Lily Blum** completed a frozen chair without error and **JJ Drada** claimed a freebie—it was the first points ever for both quizzers. Trying hard to get on the board, Lake Pointe took an error and Clifton got the toss-up for a 20-point lead going into the last question. The Jars tried hard to tie it up again and got the jump but not the answer, for a 10-point deduction. Clifton got the toss-up to end the quiz.

LP Little League-20, SCC Alabaster Jars-60, Marimont Great Delight-80

Lake Pointe's **James Fales** got the jump on question 1 and answered it correctly for his first points ever. Marimont claimed the next two questions, one by **Toby Peterson** and the next by **Ryder Perry**.

Stony Creek got on the board with a freebie taken by **Lily Blum**. Toby scored again for a 50-point Marimont lead. But the next 50 points went to Lily on another freebie and two 20-pointers so the Jars were tied for the lead on question 13. Marimont's fourth team error on 14 dropped it out of the lead by 10 points, but the Jars failed to capitalize on the toss-up. On question 15, **Madalyn Lutz** got the jump and answer for the win and a third-person bonus. Those two bonus Olympic Points were the first team bonus points for a Little League team.



Marimont Great Delight

Marimont's **Toby Peterson** froze his chair without error on question 5. Viper **Clifton Leslie** took the lead on question 10 and eventually scored 120 points for the second time on the day. The difference for the Vipers in this quiz was the 20 points added by **Isabella Spencer** on question 13 with her first jump on her first day of quizzing, and that helped the Vipers to its first high-score team bonus. **Lily Blum** got the Jars on the board to close out the quiz.

December 12, 2020 Quiz Day #3

Marimont is on the north side of Walton Boulevard in Pontiac just west of Telegraph Road. The driveway into the parking lot is on the west side of the church.

via M-59 from the east:
