## Varsity Quiz Highlights

But an error on 12 led to a toss-up taken by Owen, and the 20 points locked up the win and gave Gold the high score of the day. ## Little League Quiz Highlights

## SCC Vipers-110, LP Little League-0, Marimont Great Delight-160

The middle question of this quiz was taken by SCC's Clifton Leslie on a toss-up after he had frozen without error. The score then was 90-0-20, Madalyn Lutz having put Marimont on the board. But then Marimont scored on six consecutive questions. Toby Peterson and then Madalyn both froze without error to lock up the win. But they weren't done yet as Anna Lutz scored and secured a thirdperson bonus. A final toss-up taken by Clifton gave him 110 points in the quiz.
SCC Alabaster Jars-70, SCC Vipers-50, LP Little League-20
Lake Pointe's James Fales was first to score, with a freebie on question 3. The Vipers' Clifton Leslie scored on 4, and the Jars' Lily Blum on 8 , so with the quiz half over the score was 20-20-10. Clifton got the next two scores for a 40-point Vipers lead. Lily scored to cut the lead to 20. Joshua Fales scored on 14 to bring LP within striking distance of the Jars, so on question 15 every position was up for grabs. The Jars' Olivia Mangas got the jump and the answer to tie and send the quiz into overtime. A Vipers' error led to 10 more points to Olivia and the Jars had their first win ever in fine come-from-
 behind style.
