But an error on 12 led to a toss-up taken by Owen, and the 20 points locked up the win and gave Gold the high score of the day. But they weren't done yet as **Anna Lutz** scored and secured a third-person bonus. A final toss-up taken by Clifton gave him 110 points in the quiz.

Lake Pointe's **James Fales** was first to score, with a freebie on question 3.
