## Little League Quiz Highlights

SCC's 4th team error on 14 cost it 10 points, and Joshua got the toss-up to pull LP into a tie for second. LP missed on its effort to break the tie on 15, and Lily Blum got the toss-up to secure second for SCC and end the quiz.
