### Chicago 2021 Q & A

*Question*: Is Chicago 2021 for sure going to happen in light of COVID-19? *Answer*: No, but with the vaccine distribution and steps being taken to open up facilities there is reason for optimism.

Question: What is DBQ doing for Chicago?

Answer: DBQ [1] has secured a 15% discount at the Bourbonnais Holiday Inn Express (\$99 +tax per room per night cost), [2] will distribute complete information for Chicago 2021 before the February quiz, [3] will design and purchase T-shirts in February for quizzers, coaches and fans (\$10 quizzer and fan cost), [4] will organize 4 or 5 person teams, register them the day of the March Day of Champions Tournament and pay the \$40 team fee (\$10 quizzer cost), and [5] organize a Friday evening info meeting and Sunday morning worship meeting in Chicago.

Question: When do I have to decide about going?

*Answer*: Complete information will be distributed ahead of the February 13 quiz. Preregistration will be at the February quiz and it is requested that this year everyone try to make that a final registration. We cannot wait until the March 13 quiz to finalize who's going: T-shirts need to be ordered in February and hotel reservations need to be in advance of March 10. So stay tuned for distribution of the Chicago info pack.

**February 13 Quiz Reminders.** The venue will again be Marimont Community Church in Pontiac. Stony Creek Church will co-host.

The opening meeting will begin at 12 noon and the quiz competition at 12:30.

## Varsity Quiz Highlights

SCC Tiny Tots–70, SCC Built on the Rock–30, LP What do you want with us?–140 Tiny Tot rookie Micah Drada was first to score in the new year. Lake Pointe's Cordelia Fike scored next and froze without error on question 5. Micah froze without error on



question 6. Rock rookie **Caleb Loyd** scored, and **Annabelle Fales** retook the lead for LP. After a lull, on 13 **Sam Hatfield** scored to keep the Rock in the picture. On 14, LP's **Carmen Yonker** locked up the win with a bonus. Needing a bonus to tie for second, the Rock asked rookie **Aaron Franz** to get his first score ever. His valiant effort came up short—the toss-up went to Cordelia.

Marimont Myrrh–140, CP Take the Children's Bread–20, Marimont Gold–160 The Myrrh duo jumped out to a 90-point lead with 3 by Katie Baugh and 1 by Anna Sanchez. The Gold duo of Owen and Curtis Parker each froze without error, while Anna added her second. CrossPoint rookie Olivia Padilla, quizzing alone, tried to score and the toss-up went to Owen for the win. Anna froze without error to cut the lead to 20, but then the Marimont duos could only sit and watch Olivia score on 15 to end the quiz.

LP What do you want with us?–260, SCC Fishers of Men–30, SCC The Wise Ones–20 Teams usually can only dream of this happening—all three freezing without error in the same quiz for 40 bonus points. Lake Pointe's Cordelia Fike got things started with the first three questions. Then Annabelle Fales took her turn, sandwiched around two scores by Fishers rookie Lauren Franz. Then Carmen Yonker took her turn, sandwiched around a score by Wise One rookie Chloe Mangas. Down the stretch, the Fishers took some risks trying to build on their lead for second place but the toss-ups after their errors were gobbled up by Cordelia. ۞



## Little League Quiz Highlights

### SCC Alabaster Jars-70, LP Little League-30, Marimont Great Delight-90

After 10 questions, this quiz was extremely close at 30–20–40, with **Olivia Mangas**, **Joshua Fales** and **Toby Peterson** doing the scoring for their respective teams. On 11, Toby froze without error for a 40-point Marimont lead. On 12, SCC's **JJ Drada** cut the lead to 20. On 13, Marimont's **Anna Lutz** put the lead back to 40, meaning SCC needed both remaining questions. SCC's 4th team error on 14 cost it 10 points, and Joshua got the toss-up to pull LP into a tie for second. LP missed on its effort to break the tie on 15, and **Lily Blum** got the toss-up to secure second for SCC and end the quiz.

### Marimont Great Delight-40, SCC Vipers-20, SCC Alabaster Jars-80

The scoring was in spurts in this quiz; questions 5-7 opened the scoring with a correct answer by each team: the Jars' **Olivia Mangas**, Marimont's **Toby Peterson**, and the Vipers' **Clifton Leslie**. Two more errors and a rare passed question followed, when the Jars broke the stalemate with a score by **JJ Drada** followed by Olivia's second. Clifton got his second, and going into question 14 the score was 20–40–60. The Vipers' 4th error led to a toss-up taken by Olivia for a frozen chair and a lock on the win. A 5th Vipers error on 15 led to a toss-up taken by **Ryder Perry** to claim second for Marimont.

### SCC Vipers-130, SCC Alabaster Jars-20, LP Little League-0

The Vipers' **Clifton Leslie** froze without error with scores on questions 1, 6, 7. **Joshua Fales** got Lake Pointe on the board with a freebie on question 10. Back in on a toss-up, Clifton bumped the Vipers' score to 90. **JJ Drada** got Alabaster Jars on the board with a freebie on question 13B. However, the Jars' 4th team error on 14 saw that 10 points immediately disappear, and Clifton claimed another toss-up. Trying to nail down second place on 15, LP erred and saw its 10 points disappear. The Vipers' **Bella Spencer** got the toss-up to end regulation. On the tie-breaker, the Jars' **Lily Blum** got the jump and made no mistake on the answer to take second place.
