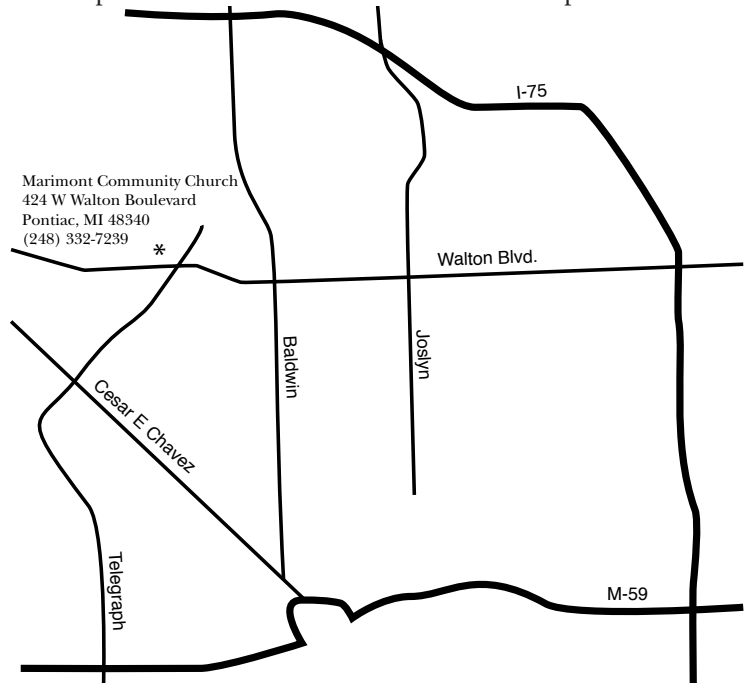

# Tidbits

**Honorable Mention.** Once frozen, there is no guarantee that a quizzer will have an opportunity to jump and score again. Three frozen chairs without error in a day of quizzing equals 210 points. When quizzers get that many points or more and yet don't make Quizzer of the Month, they deserve some recognition. In October, one Little League and three Varsity quizzers attained this distinction:

**Rookie Watch.** A great part of quizzing is to see which rookies start off strong and which are able to catch on later and make a run for the top spot. This season there are lots of rookies to watch—especially in Little League where 24 of the 33 quizzers are rookies.

In Varsity, two rookies, **Landon Komer** and **Zeke Whitaker** find themselves in All Star status with 100 points each, Landon getting the lead for now on one less error. Also garnering multiple scores on the day was **Aiden Baugh**, while **Samuel Kochensparger** and **Xander Wilks** both scored once.

In Little League, 5 rookies scored in the triple digits, led by **Zoey Johnson** at 180 and **Kenadee Koch** at 170; 6 more had multiple scores; **Brody Newcombe** and **Silas Pennington** each got on the scoreboard for the first time.

# Varsity Quiz Highlights

## CP More than Conquerors–30, SCC Unashamed–70, LP Unaware–110



SCC Unashamed

In this first quiz of the new season, Stony Creek's rookie **Julian Hjelmberg** was called on to answer question 1, and he answered correctly, but then the quizmaster realized it was another quizzer's light that had come on. Following the redo, Lake Pointe grabbed the lead and did not let go as **Annabelle Fales** and **Erin Yonker** each scored twice. CrossPoint's **Olivia Padilla** also scored twice.

Finally, the young SCC team came back to life as rookie **Zeke Whiteaker** scored on 11 and 13A and **Olivia Mangas**, in her first Varsity quiz, scored on 14 to take over second place, in striking distance of first. LP bravely went for the winning score, but took an error that dropped their lead to 10. With a bonus available to catch second place, CP got the jump on the toss-up but not the answer. The freebie was too tough for SCC, but it didn't matter as LP's **Megan Yonker** closed out the quiz with a correct answer to give her team the third-person bonus for two Olympic points.

## SCC Fishers of Men–70, SCC Was It Paul?–50, CP More than Conquerors–40

Last season, this quiz would have ended regulation at 60–40–40 and gone to a tie-breaker. Not so this season, as teams get a second-person bonus. **Abby McClusky** got the Fishers on the board first, but CP's **Olivia Padilla** promptly tied it up. The Fishers responded with two in a row by Abby and **Kara Russell** for a 50-point lead. The other Stony team then came to life and **Caleb Loyd** and **Sam Hatfield** scored on 13 and 14. Olivia got her second score on 15 but no bonus, and that was the quiz.

## LP Unaware–100, LP We are Lawbreakers–60, SCC Animals and Reptiles–120

Lawbreaker **Cordelia Fike** was first to freeze, on question 6. SCC's **Owen Parker** froze without error on 10 and picked up a toss-up on 12A for a 30-point lead. Unaware's **Erin Yonker** then froze without error on 13, and **Annabelle Fales** grabbed 14 to move into the lead by 10. SCC rookie **Xander Wilks** got his first score ever to claim the win.

## LP We are Lawbreakers–80, Marimont Scorching Heat–130, The Peace Brothers–40

Marimont's **Katie Baugh** and LP's **Cordelia Fike** froze without error on questions 3 and 6 respectively. Rookie **Samuel Kochensparger** then got Peace on the board. In on a toss-up, Cordelia took the lead but Marimont took it back on a score by rookie **Aiden Baugh**. Rookie **Landon Komer** scored on 12, pulling Peace within 40 points of second. Down the stretch, Katie capitalized on errors by the other teams to score 30 more points on her way to Quizzer of the Month.

## Little League Quiz Highlights

### SCC Girl Squad–70, LP Cute Penguins–150, SCC Kickin’ Quizzers–100

This was the overall top-scoring quiz of the day as there was only one error and 4 quizzers froze without error: Kickin’ Quizzer **Lily Blum** on question 5, LP’s **James Fales** and **Joshua Fales** on 8 and 13 respectively, and Girl Squad rookie **Zoey Johnson** on 14 (in her first quiz ever). At that point, with the entire LP team frozen and the win locked up, the last question was essentially a tie-breaker for second. Kickin’ Quizzer **JJ Drada** got the jump and the answer for second place.

### Woodland Bible Wookies–60, SCC Vipers–80, Marimont Animals–100

This quiz was as close as can be, all tied at 70 going into question 15. SCC and Marimont did it with **Clifton Leslie** and **Toby Peterson** respectively freezing without error, while Woodland got two scores from rookie **Harper Beach** and one from rookie **Jayden Beach**. Rookie **Nadyah Peterson** got the jump and score to win it for Marimont. The quiz went into overtime to break the tie for second; Woodland got the jump but not the answer and Clifton closed out the quiz with a freebie, which ultimately made the difference for him attaining Quizzer of the Month.

### Marimont Animals–100, SPN Cool Cheetahs–120, LP Cute Penguins–90

Here’s another quiz as close as can be, all tied at 100 going into question 15, each team doing it with a frozen chair without error by one quizzer and a score by a second quizzer. For LP, it was **James Fales** and **Timothy Graff**; for SPN, it was rookies **Kenadee Koch** and **Alison Balavenderan**; for Marimont, it was **Toby Peterson** and rookie **Nadyah Peterson**. An LP error on 15 cost it 10 points; on the toss-up Alison got her second score to win the quiz.

### SPN Bible Warriors–40, SCC Kickin’ Quizzers–180, Woodland Bible Wookies–0

This fourth round quiz briefly featured the highest score by a single team: 180 points. SCC did that with **Lily Blum** freezing without error and later scoring a freebie and **JJ Drada** freezing without error and later claiming a toss-up. St Paul of Northville took second as rookie **James Yount** scored on questions 9 and 16.

### SPN The Unburstables–50, Marimont Animals–220, SCC Girl Squad–20

SCC rookie **Zoey Johnson** immediately scored. SPN then took the lead on two scores by rookie **Emersyn Haverkate**, who would later get 15A to claim second place. In between, Marimont’s 4 quizzers combined for 9 scores with 50 bonus points: **Madalyn Lutz** 40, rookie **Nadyah Peterson** 20, **Anna Lutz** and **Toby Peterson** both freezing without error for 70 each. 🌟
