Need-to-know for “Day of Champions” Tournament. The venue will again be Marimont Community Church in Pontiac. Almost everything else is different from prior quiz days, so please review the following.

There will be one or two more rooms in use than normal, so bringing your quiz boxes is that much more important. Quizmasters, please arrive by 7:45 a.m.

The opening meeting will begin at 8:00 a.m. Plan on staying all day. Bring snacks and there will be a lunch break when you can go out—or bring a lunch to eat at the church.

During the morning session, teams will each compete six times to complete the regular season. After lunch, playoff brackets will be announced.

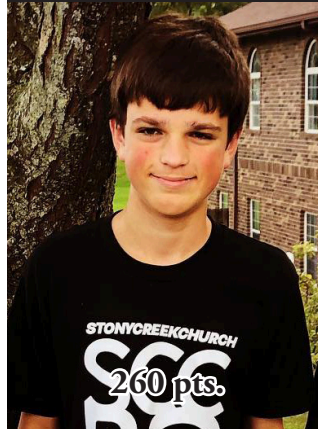
Mid-afternoon will see the Little League Finals followed by the Varsity Finals. Capping the day will be an Awards Ceremony. For each division, awards will include team Champion and two finalists, All Stars (top 8 Varsity and top 9 Little League individuals), Dream Team (top 4 individuals in the six morning quizzes), Rookie of the Year, and Most Improved Quizzer (biggest increase in average from beginning to end of the six morning quizzes).

One more thing: individuals selected for Chicago teams will be announced by the end of the awards ceremony (the team line-ups will be announced no later than the All Teams Practice on March 20). Then, before heading home, each one going with DBQ to the Chicago 2022 Tournament needs to confirm that with the following costs submitted to Jerry Graff:

- *quizzers*: \$22 for team fee and T-shirt,
- *parents and fans*: \$12 if you order a T-shirt. ✪

Tidbits

Honorable Mention. Once frozen, there is no guarantee that a quizzer will have an opportunity to jump and score again. Three frozen chairs without error in a day of quizzing equals 210 points. When quizzers get that many points or more and yet don't make Quizzer of the Month, they deserve some recognition. In February, three Varsity quizzers attained this distinction:

Rookie Watch. A great part of quizzing is to see which rookies start off strong and which are able to catch on later and make a run for the top spot.

Varsity Quiz Highlights

SCC Unashamed–20, LP Unaware–150, LP We are Lawbreakers–120

Lawbreaker **Cordelia Fike** froze without error with scores on questions 1, 4 and 6. That matched Unaware's three scores, two by **Annabelle Fales** and one by **Erin Yonker**. But Unaware took the lead for good with the next three scores—Annabelle froze without error, Erin got her second, and **Megan Yonker** scored. With only two quizzers, the Lawbreakers needed the last three questions to tie, but they would sit out the tiebreaker while Erin and Megan picked a winner. **Carmen Yonker** did keep the Lawbreakers in the running on questions 13 and 14, but Stony Creek was not going to be shut out and rookie **Zeke Whiteaker** claimed the last question to put SCC on the board.

The Peace Brothers–10, SCC Was It Paul?–100, Marimont Scorching Heat–190



SCC Was It Paul?

Marimont's three quizzers all participated in scoring the first 120 points of this quiz—a frozen chair for **Katie Baugh** and a score each for **Ryder Perry** and **Aiden Baugh**. **Sam Hatfield** broke that streak with a score on question 8 for Stony Creek, but Aiden took the next two to freeze without error and put a lock on first place. Sam scored again, before rookie **Landon Komer** brought Peace into play. Sam responded with his third to freeze without error and teammate **Caleb Loyd** scored to lock up second place. A 15A toss-up was taken by Aiden to close out the quiz.

SCC Fishers of Men–70, CP More than Conquerors–20, SCC Unashamed–100

Unashamed rookie **Zeke Whiteaker** scored the first 80 points of the quiz, squeezing in a freebie before freezing without error. **Kara Russell** put the Fishers on the board before Zeke completed Unashamed's scoring on a toss-up. Kara scored again, but CrossPoint's **Olivia Padilla** scored to make it just a one-jump difference for second. On the last question, Fisher **Abby McClusky** got the jump and answer to preserve second place.



CP More than Conquerors

Marimont Scorching Heat–210, SCC Animals and Reptiles–70, SCC Fishers of Men–40

Katie Baugh got all the points Marimont needed when she froze without error on question 3, but rookie **Aiden Baugh** added 90 more with three-in-a-row to freeze without error on question 7 followed by a toss-up on 13A, and **Ryder Perry** added 30 on 12 and 14B. Fishers of Men went into question 15 with a 30-point lead for second on scores by **Abby McClusky** and **Kara Russell**. The Animals were on the board with a score by **Owen Parker**. On 15, **Eli Blum** got the jump and answer to send the quiz into overtime with a tie-breaker for second place. Following errors that continued the tie at 40–40, rookie **Xander Wilks** won the tie-breaker on 18 and gave the Animals two Olympic bonus points. ★

Little League Quiz Highlights

SCC Girl Squad–70, SCC Kickin’ Quizzers–100, SCC Vipers–120

The three Stony Creek teams got together for the first time this season, and it was an epic match. **Clifton Leslie** promptly put the Vipers on the board, but Kickin’ **Lily Blum** took the lead with two in a row. Clifton took the lead back with three in a row, freezing without error followed by a toss-up. Lily froze without error to pull within 20. The all-rookie Girl Squad scored three in a row—two by **Zoey Johnson** either side of one by **Ava Kopp**. Going into question 14, the score was 70–70–90. Kickin’ rookie **Charlie Blum** got her second score of the season to take the lead back. It was still anyone’s quiz going into question 15. Vipers’ rookie **Zoe Whiteaker** got the jump and the answer for the win.

SPN Bible Warriors–20, Woodland Word Warriors–150, SPN Cool Cheetahs–60

This was an all-rookie quiz. **Caleb Norton** started things off for the Bible Warriors. Then **Alison Balavederan** put the Cheetahs on the board. Woodland was third to score but quickly took the lead on two jumps from **Elijah Newcombe** followed by one from **Brody Newcombe**. Alison got her second score to pull within one bonus score of Woodland, but Brody responded with his second score followed by Elijah’s frozen chair without error for an 80-point lead. When question 13 was passed, victory was assured but **Leyton Wise** took question 14 to put an exclamation point on Woodland’s win. Alison came through on 15 to freeze her chair.

This quiz was about as close as can be all the way to the wire. Woodland rookie **Harper Beach** scored first. St. Paul rookie **Alison Balavederan** responded to tie. Harper scored twice to freeze and take a 40-point lead. St. Paul scored twice—first by rookie **Kenadee Koch** and then Alison’s second—for a 10-point lead. Woodland rookie **Jayden Beach** scored to take the lead back. Kenadee tied it with her second score. Jayden scored his second to go into question 15 with a 20-point lead. Kenadee scored to freeze and send the quiz into overtime for a tiebreaker. Jayden scored to freeze and claim the win.

SCC Vipers–140, SPN Bible Warriors–0, SPN The Unburstables–70

Through question 12, Stony Creek and The Unburstables each had three scores: SCC had two by **Clifton Leslie** and one by rookie **Zoe Whiteaker** for 70 points, while The Unburstables had one from each of its three rookies, **Joshua Norton**, **Declan Yount** (his first) and **Emersyn Haverkate** for 80 points. But it was all SCC after that as Clifton completed his freeze without error and added a toss-up and Zoe took the last question.

Schedule

February 12: All quizzers, coaches, officials and parents are asked to complete a pre-registration form at the February quiz. Even if you know that you will not be going to Chicago, it helps the Steering Committee to have that information.

March 12: Quizzers will be announced, and teams may be announced. Confirm you are going and pay for quizzing team fee and/or T-shirts to Jerry Graff by the end of the Day of Champions Tournament.

March 18 (Friday): Deadline to get the reservation discount at the hotel.

March 20 (Sunday): All Chicago Teams Practice. 2:30–4:30 P.M. at Lake Pointe Bible Church, 42150 Schoolcraft Rd, Plymouth, MI 48170. If teams haven't yet been announced, this is when you will learn your team and will pick a team name.

April 1: Hotel check-in begins at 3:00 P.M. An orientation meeting will be held Friday evening at 9:00 (Chicago time) in the conference room. This is a mandatory meeting for all Detroit Bible Quizzing participants.

April 2: On Saturday, breakfast at the hotel is between 6:00–7:35 A.M. Quizzing starts at 8:00 A.M. at the university, but plan on being there by 7:45 A.M.

April 3: On Sunday morning, breakfast at the hotel is between 6:00–9:00 A.M. We will have a joint worship service/sharing time starting at 9:00 A.M. Check-out is 11:00 A.M.

Advance Costs

Team Fee and Shirts. DBQ will (1) register the teams with the World Bible Quiz Association (\$40 per team) and (2) design and obtain the T-shirts. The per person cost of these two items is payable to DBQ and to be given to Jerry Graff on March 12, as follows:

- for *quizzers*, the cost is \$10 toward the team fee and \$12 for the shirt, for a total of \$22.
- for *coaches*, the T-shirt is complimentary.
- for *others*, the T-shirt is optional, but if you want one (the cost is \$12) please order it on February 12.

Hotel. DBQ has arranged a discount at the Best Western Express Plus (see below). However, each quiz group or family needs to make its own arrangements with the hotel to reserve your room(s). The discount rate is \$109.00 per room per night plus tax. The discounted reservation deadline is Friday, March 18.

Locations

We will be staying at the Best Western Plus Hotel & Suites. The address is 62 Ken Hayes Drive, Bourbonnais, IL, 60914. The front desk line is (815) 932-4411. The web site is https://www.bestwestern.com/en_US.html. Plan on about 5-6 hours travel time from the Detroit area.

We will be quizzing at Olivet Nazarene University in Bourbonnais, IL. The address is 1 University Ave, Bourbonnais, IL 60914. The web site is <http://www.olivet.edu>. The school is 3 miles southwest of the hotel; plan on a 10-minute drive

How Are Teams Made Up?

Every quizzing leader who qualifies for the Chicago Tournament gets placed in a pool. A team of quizzing leaders get together and put the teams together like an intricate puzzle. This team-makeup committee considers quizzers' local performance all year long (but especially in the March Day of Champions Tournament), their home location and how close they are to other quizzers in their area, their specialization (if they have one) and overall team chemistry. Each team is then assigned a coach that best fits that team's makeup.

Will There Be An All Teams Practice?

Yes, from 2:30–4:30 P.M. on Sunday, March 20, at Lake Pointe Bible Church, 42150 Schoolcraft Rd, Plymouth, MI 48170.

Coaches are encouraged to be creative and try to get their team together for practice on another day as well, perhaps with another team as well.

What About Transportation To Chicago?

Each church or quizzing group is responsible for its own transportation. There may be room in another church's van for you if you need a ride, but you must make your need known.

What About Food?

Breakfast is included in the hotel's room charge. All of your remaining meals for the weekend will be on your own. Plan on whatever meals you will have while traveling and then add Friday dinner, Saturday lunch and dinner, and Sunday lunch going home. You should have somewhere between 4-7 total meals depending on when you travel.

How Does Someone Get A DBQ T-Shirt?

At the hotel on Friday evening, there will be a DBQ orientation meeting. At that time, the DBQ T-shirts for the Tournament will be unveiled. This year, all the DBQ T-shirts will be the same color.

What Stuff Should Be Brought?

A medical release form for quizzers 17 and under who will not be accompanied by a parent. What else: swimsuit for the indoor pool, work-out gear for the Fitness Center, quiz portion and study materials (for last minute review!), clothing appropriate for the season (stay warm and dry!).

Make sure that you plan on getting to know others outside of your own church. Take a risk. Make a new friend. Scripture says that the world will know us by the kind of love we show each other as Christians. Let's make sure we show them exactly what the Lord meant by that. It's gonna be a great time!
