March 11 Quiz Reminders.

Need-to-know for "Day of Champions" Tournament. The venue will be Marimont Community Church, 424 W Walton Blvd, Pontiac MI 48340. Almost everything else is different from prior quiz days, so please review the following.

There will be three more rooms in use than normal, so bringing your quiz boxes is that much more important. Quizmasters, please arrive by 7:45 a.m.

The opening meeting will begin at 8:00 a.m. Plan on staying all day. Bring snacks and there will be a lunch break when you can go out—or bring a lunch to eat at the church.

During the morning session, teams will each compete six times to complete the regular season. After lunch, playoff brackets will be announced.

Mid-afternoon will see the Little League Finals followed by the Varsity Finals. Capping the day will be an Awards Ceremony. For each division, awards will include team Champion and two finalists, All Stars (top 10 Varsity and top 12 Little League individuals), the Character Counts award, Rookie of the Year, Most Improved Quizzer (biggest increase in average from beginning to end of the six morning quizzes), and Dream Team (top 4 individuals in the six morning quizzes).

One more thing: individuals selected for Chicago teams will be announced by the end of the awards ceremony (the team line-ups will be announced no later than the All Teams Practice on March 19). Then, if you haven't got it done earlier in the day, before heading home, each one going with DBQ to the Chicago 2023 Tournament needs to confirm that with the following costs submitted to Jerry Graff:

Varsity Quiz Highlights

SCC Drunk on New Wine–110, SCC Field of Blood–20, CP Why are you surprised–0 Micah Drada and Eli Blum gave Drunk on New Wine a quick 40-point lead. Micah pushed the lead to 100 with jumps on 6, 10 and 12. There was no further score until New Wine gave up 10 on question 16 and then Micah got first place declared for New Wine on 18A. The first tiebreaker saw CrossPoint fail to capitalize after a Field of Blood error. The second tiebreaker saw Field of Blood fail to capitalize after a CP error that left the CP team erred out. So CP was unable to respond after a Field of Blood error on the third tiebreaker. On question 22 (the 4th tiebreaker), JJ Drada scored to claim second.

LP Furious Dispute–140, MCC Counted Worthy–110, SCC Full of Power–20 Halfway through the quiz, the score was 40–110–0, as Marimont's **Katie Baugh** scored

on 1, 2 and 4, and teammate Madalyn Lutz scored on 5 and 8. Lake Pointe was on the board with a score each by Carmen Yonker and Nathan Mayer. In the second half, Carmen scored again, Cordelia Fike scored to add a third-person bonus, and Nathan scored again to pull into a tie on question 12. Nathan froze without error on 14 for a 30-point lead, and that held up for the win when Stony Creek rookie Aurora Sittenauer got 15.

SCC then turned to its rookies. Field of Blood's **Eden Nelson** scored in a bid for second place. But Justus' **Hailey Boyd** matched that to send the quiz into overtime. After a Field of Blood error, Hailey got the freebie to claim second.

Field of Blood rookie **Eden Nelson** got the first score of the quiz. Lake Pointe then ran off 110 unanswered points: a frozen chair without error by **Cordelia Fike** and two scores by **Nathan Mayer**. Allow Me To Speak rookie **Dalia Parker** scored, just before **Carmen Yonker** ended regulation with a third-person bonus for LP. For a while, this tiebreaker looked like it might rival Field of Blood's first of the day, but on 20A **Lily Blum** answered the freebie to claim second.

February 11: All quizzers, coaches, officials and parents are asked to complete a pre-registration form at the February quiz. Even if you know that you will not be going to Chicago, it helps the Steering Committee to have that information.

March 11: Quizzers will be announced, and teams may be announced. Confirm you are going and pay for quizzer team fee and/or T-shirts to Jerry Graff by the end of the Day of Champions Tournament.

March 14 (Tuesday): Deadline to get the reservation discount at the hotel.

March 20 (Sunday): All Chicago Teams Practice. 2:30–5:00 P.M. at Lake Pointe Bible Church, 42150 Schoolcraft Rd, Plymouth, MI 48170. If teams haven't yet been announced, this is when you will learn your team and will pick a team name.

March 24: Hotel check-in begins at 3:00 P.M. An orientation meeting will be held Friday evening at 9:00 (Chicago time) in the conference room. This is a mandatory meeting for all Detroit Bible Quizzing participants.

How Are Teams Made Up?

Every quizzer who qualifies for the Chicago Tournament gets placed in a pool. A team of quizzing leaders get together and put the teams together like an intricate puzzle. This team-makeup committee considers quizzers' local performance all year long (but especially in the March Day of Champions Tournament), their home location and how close they are to other quizzers in their area, their specialization (if they have one) and overall team chemistry. Each team is then assigned a coach that best fits that team's makeup.

Will There Be An All Teams Practice?

Yes, from 2:30–5:00 P.M. on Sunday, March 20, at Lake Pointe Bible Church, 42150 Schoolcraft Rd, Plymouth, MI 48170.

Coaches are encouraged to be creative and try to get their team together for practice on another day as well, perhaps with another team as well.

What About Transportation To Chicago?

Each church or quizzing group is responsible for its own transportation. There may be room in another church's van for you if you need a ride, but you must make your need known.

What About Food?

Breakfast is included in the hotel's room charge. All of your remaining meals for the weekend will be on your own. Plan on whatever meals you will have while traveling and then add Friday dinner, Saturday lunch and dinner, and Sunday lunch going home. You should have somewhere between 4-7 total meals depending on when you travel.

How Does Someone Get A DBQ T-Shirt?
