Varsity Quiz Highlights

Epic Sauce the Knees–90, Absolute Faith–130, NR Love Has No Fear–60

Epic's **Leo Hile** and Faith's **Curtis Parker** split the first four questions. Curtis then froze without error and **Toby Pyke** scored, so Leo's third to freeze without error left him 20 points behind. Down the stretch, Northridge's **Ella Darichuk** shook off two errors and scored three to freeze, while Toby scored twice to freeze without error. With a commanding 70-point lead, Faith's sub tried for a team bonus on 15 but came up short. Leo got the toss-up to hang onto second place.

This was the only January quiz where a team not named MCC scored over 200 points. Northridge rookie **Justice Kooistra** bookended the quiz with scores on 1 and 15; rookie **Caleb Mills** took 3-5 to freeze without error and later took a toss-up; **Fallyn Sollosi** added a third-person bonus to go along with her frozen chair without error. Stony Creek's **Kylie Phillips** slipped in 30 points in between all the NR scores. Epic was hampered having just one quizzer as winter camp took a toll on their numbers.

SCC Whole Batch of Dough–80, MCC Raised in Glory–210, CP Fulfilled Among Us–20

Marimont took the first 7 questions: **Toby Peterson** and **Sam Kochensparger** froze without error and **Asher Kittleman** added a bonus. Quizzing solo, **Journey Clark** found an opportunity on 8 to get CrossPoint on the board. Then Stony Creek got going: **Kara Russell** picked up three to freeze without error and **Everett Smith** added a score. Once SCC had second place well in hand, they pushed for more scores, leading to Toby and Sam each getting a toss-up. In the end, this was the only quiz where MCC fell short of 220 points.

Rule 3.1.6.4 was then invoked to unfreeze Leo and James for the tie-breaker. James got the jump but not the answer, and Leo took the freebie for second place. ★

January 10: All quizzers, coaches, officials and parents are asked to complete an online pre-registration form. Use this QR code or go the bottom of the Quizzify DBQ Stats page. Even if you know that you will not be going to Chicago, it helps the Steering Committee to have your information.



February 14: Quizzers complete qualifying.

February 14: Confirm you are going and pay for quizzing team fee and/or T-shirts to Jerry Graff by the end of the competition.

March 6: Deadline to get the reservation discount at the hotel.

March 20: Hotel check-in begins at 3:00 P.M. An orientation meeting will be held Friday evening at 9:00 (Chicago time) in the conference room. This is a mandatory meeting for all Detroit Bible Quizzing participants.

March 21: On Saturday, breakfast at the hotel is between 6:00–8:00 A.M. Quizzing will start at about 8:30 A.M. at the university.

Advance Costs

Team Fee and Shirts. DBQ will (1) register the teams with the World Bible Quiz Association (\$80 per team) and (2) design and obtain the T-shirts. The per person cost of these two items is payable to DBQ and to be given to Jerry Graff on March 8, as follows:

How Are Teams Made Up?

Every quizzing leader who qualifies for the Chicago Tournament gets placed in a pool. A team of quizzing leaders get together and put the teams together like an intricate puzzle. This team-make-up committee considers quizzers' local performance all year long, their home location and how close they are to other quizzers in their area, their specialization (if they have one) and overall team chemistry. Each team is then assigned a coach that best fits that team's makeup.

Will There Be An All Teams Practice?

No, not with Chicago coming just one week after the March Day of Champions Tournament. But coaches are encouraged to be creative and try to get their team together for practice, perhaps with another team as well.

What About Transportation To Chicago?

Each church or quizzing group is responsible for its own transportation. There may be room in another church's van for you if you need a ride, but you must make your need known.

What About Food?

Breakfast is included in the hotel's room charge. All of your remaining meals for the weekend will be on your own. Plan on whatever meals you will have while traveling and then add Friday dinner, Saturday lunch and dinner, and Sunday lunch going home. You should have somewhere between 4-7 total meals depending on when you travel.

How Does Someone Get A DBQ T-Shirt?

At the hotel on Friday evening, there will be a DBQ orientation meeting. At that time, the DBQ T-shirts for the Tournament will be unveiled.

What Stuff Should Be Brought?

A medical release form for quizzers 17 and under who will not be accompanied by a parent (sample attached). What else: swimsuit for the indoor pool, work-out gear for the Fitness Center, quiz portion and study materials (for last minute review!), clothing appropriate for the season (stay warm and dry!).
